

**MINUTES**  
**DETROIT CITY COUNCIL**  
**REGULAR MEETING AUGUST 10, 2021**

The Detroit City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, August 10, 2021 at 6:32 P.M. Mayor Kenny Snodgrass called the meeting to order. Council members in attendance were Brandon Brown, Terrie Shelby, Shane Cabler and Lori Melton.

No public attendance

New business discussed:

- a. Motion was made by Lori Melton and seconded by Shane Cabler to adopt the previously proposed property tax rate of 0.499999%. Motion carried 4-0
- b. Motion was made by Terrie Shelby and seconded by Lori Melton to approve the 2021-2022 Water/Sewer budget as submitted. Motion carried 4-0
- c. Motion was made by Brandon Brown and seconded by Shane Cabler to approve the 2021-2022 General Fund budget as submitted. Motion carried 4-0
- d. Motion was made by Brandon Brown and seconded by Lori Melton to purchase a new zero turn Kubota mower (with 1 yr extended warranty) from Paris Farm and Ranch (ZZ781DWTi – 60). Motion carried 4-0
- e. Motion was made by Terrie Shelby and seconded by Lori Melton to purchase 2.25” base rock for W. San Diego as bid by RK Hall and spread by county to address the failing base of the road. Motion carried 4-0
- f. Council was advised of upcoming September 30th deadline for 3yr Lead and Copper testing as required by TCEQ – non action item

Old Business discussed:

- a. L. Clanton getting bids from Rays Tree Service for removal of trees along 3<sup>rd</sup> NE

Motion was made by Brandon Brown and seconded by Shane Cabler to approve the monthly bills along with invoices from:

- a. Detroit Auto - \$773.46 – fuel pump replacement
- b. Gist Enterprises - \$12,543.00 – work in June on street patching, brush trimming, blading, ditch & culvert repairs.
- c. Allen Lumber - \$2,331.00 -culverts (\$945.00 billed to residents - \$1,386.00 for city ROW and streets)
- d. TML - \$591.00 – membership renewal
