

MINUTES
DETROIT CITY COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING NOVEMBER 16, 2021

The Detroit City Council met in a rescheduled, regular session on Tuesday, December 14, 2021 at 6:34 P.M. Mayor Kenny Snodgrass called the meeting to order. Council members in attendance were Faye Marshall, Shane Cabler, Terrie Shelby, Brandon Brown, and Lori Melton.

There were no residents present for public comment.

New business discussed:

- Motion was made Terrie Shelby and seconded by Lori Melton to purchase a new city truck through BuyBoard (2023 Chevrolet 2500 ¾ ton, cab and chassis) and a utility style bed from Jerry Madewell Welding. Motion carried 5-0
- Motion was made by Lori Melton and seconded by Brandon Brown to purchase a new office computer and monitor from Professional Business Systems (old computer will be kept for water/wastewater online training, etc). Motion carried 5-0
- Council was advised of TCEQ monitoring violation – the violation was due to an inaccurate sampling schedule. Richard Shipp spoke to a TCEQ inspector and is making the needed schedule and procedural changes as well as providing all necessary documentation to TCEQ.

Old Business discussed:

- Council was advised of the December tax allocation to the EDC of \$2,908.73
- Council was advised of the finalized approval of the City's wastewater treatment permit – good for 5 years

After review, Motion was made by Brandon Brown and seconded by Shane Cabler to approve the regular monthly bills as well as those listed below. Motion carried 5-0

- \$6,100.00 Gist Enterprises – Rock and grading on S. Main St. and W. San Diego St.
- \$299.00 Texas Tank – annual TCEQ water tower inspection
- \$820.75 TCEQ – water system fee FY2022
