DETROIT CITY COUNCIL

REGULAR MEETING NOVEMBER 16, 2021

The Detroit City Council met in a rescheduled, regular session on Wednesday, November 10, 2021 at 6:33 P.M. Mayor Kenny Snodgrass called the meeting to order. Council members in attendance were Faye Marshall, Shane Cabler, Terrie Shelby, Brandon Brown, and Lori Melton.

There were no residents present for public comment.

New business discussed:

- Motion was made by Brandon Brown and seconded by Lori Melton to sign a vendor agreement with Community Services of Northeast Texas, Inc to provide emergency assistance to low-income households for arrearages for disconnected households or those at-risk of disconnection. Motion carried 5-0
- Motion was made by Lori Melton and seconded by Terrie Shelby to approve and have the Mayor sign Resolution 2021-11-09 adopting Texas Opioid Settlement Agreements, the Texas Term Sheet and its intrastate allocation schedule. Motion carried 5-0
- Discussion among council regarding new city truck purchase through BuyBoard resulted in decision to move forward with bids/purchasing a ³/₄ ton, utility style, flatbed, etc type truck.

- Motion was made by Terrie Shelby and seconded by Lori Melton to use The Municipal Law Firm of Messer, Fort & McDonald for the City's legal needs. Motion carried 5-0
- Council was advised of the full repayment of \$2,655.66 in expenses caused by Atmos contractors hitting a water line near the Elementary school on 10/21/2021.
- Council was advised of the 3rd half cent sales tax allocation to the EDC
- Motion was made by Lori Melton and seconded by Shane to pay annual employee bonuses. Motion carried 5-0
