

MINUTES
DETROIT CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING
December 12, 2023

The Detroit City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, December 12, 2023, at 7:07 P.M. Mayor Kenny Snodgrass called the meeting to order. Council members in attendance were Terrie Shelby, Faye Marshall, Josh Daigle and Tonya Clanton.

Public Comment – The new owners of the J&S Git’N Go, KB and Jessie, were present for public comment. They wanted to formally introduce themselves to the City Council. They also informed the Council that they had been approached by many members of the community regarding introducing sales of beer and wine at the store. They are looking in to the process and will keep the Council updated.

New business discussed:

- Ratification of employee bonus (previously approved by text 11/22/2023 - 3 for and 1 against full bonus for all employees)
- Potential speed study for business district of Hwy 82 – discussion was unanimous veto at the present, for fear of it rendering an even higher speed limit.
- Added after the agenda was published – Red River County Pct. 2 Commissioner David Hutson will be working on the road through the Detroit Cemetery and East Norris St.

Old Business discussed/actioned:

- S. Main Street grant update – TDA CDBG CDV21-0388 –The City met with 5W Construction for a pre-construction meeting on October 30, 2023. Michael Williams, contractor, stated that they would not be able to start until January 2024 but assured the City that he would be complete by the February 28, 2024 deadline.
- ARP – American Rescue Plan Funds – remaining funds of \$56,514.01 must be obligated to a project by 12/31/24 – and projects completed and funded by 12/31/2026.
- April 2024 Eclipse
- Old City Hall – structural repairs completed. Next items include interior paint and flooring.
- Rock rake stabilization – S&S Welding to add support bars

Motion was made by Terrie Shelby and seconded by Faye Marshall to approve the regular monthly bills as well as those listed below. Motion carried 4-0

- Texas Tank - \$299.00 – water tower annual inspection
