

**MINUTES**  
**DETROIT CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING**  
**June 13, 2023**

The Detroit City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, June 13, 2023, at 7:05 P.M. Mayor Kenny Snodgrass called the meeting to order. Council members in attendance were Lori Melton, Terrie Shelby, Josh Daigle, and Tonya Clanton.

No public comment

New business discussed:

- Motion was made by Lori Melton and seconded by Josh Daigle to approve the placement of the Veteran's Memorial to the open space between the Tabernacle and the Library. Motion approved 4-0
- Motion was made by Josh Daigle and seconded by Lori Melton to approve bank debit/credit cards (1 from GF and 1 from WS) for purchases that will not accept PO or charge accounts for the City. Motion carried 4-0
- Motion was made by Terrie Shelby and seconded by Josh Daigle to purchase a brush/rock rake attachment for the mini excavator. Motion carried 4-0

Old Business discussed/actioned:

- Smoke Testing completed – cleanout tops being replaced, issue in line near DISD WSSSR building.
- S. Main Street grant update – TDA CDBG CDV21-0388 – contractor bids open and will close 6/29/23
- Crittenden Street project – Gist work completed, City continuing to work on creek clean out and culverts
- ARP – American Rescue Plan funds – current balance \$73,166.66
- City Park equipment – mulch delivered; cross ties being donated through Allen Lumber – waiting on weather
- Big Truck parking on Front Street – signs have to be custom ordered according to TXDOT regulations
